The Clinch-Powell Enterprise Community has announced the availability of funds for grant making to 501c3 agencies or their sponsor or unit of government.

These monies are designated for programs and projects, which will directly impact upon the residents of the Enterprise Community. The area covers specific census tracts within the five counties of: Hawkins, Hancock, Grainger, Union and Claiborne. Agencies or units of government need not be located in the specific area but rather provide programs, which will target the areas most underserved.

The broad goals to which the grants will service are in the area of: Sustainable Economic Development, Tourism, Education and Arts, Basic Needs, Infrastructure, and Quality Care.
