You may also include a church, quilts, logging, Indians, and Melungeon scenes. Remember this will be put on the side of a barn so limit your details and colors.

The designs **must be in color** on 14”x22” sheets (half of a poster board) with your name and phone number on the back. The designs may be left at the County Executive’s Office on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of the Court House 8:00-4:00 Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri. The deadline is March 22 at 4 pm.

The East Tennessee Foundation through the Arts Build Community program of the Tennessee Arts Commission has funded this project with matching funds from the Clinch-Powell Enterprise Community.

The “Not Barn Yesterday” project has two purposes: (1) to enhance community spirit and cooperation through community art and (2) to continue building on our rich cultural heritage.
